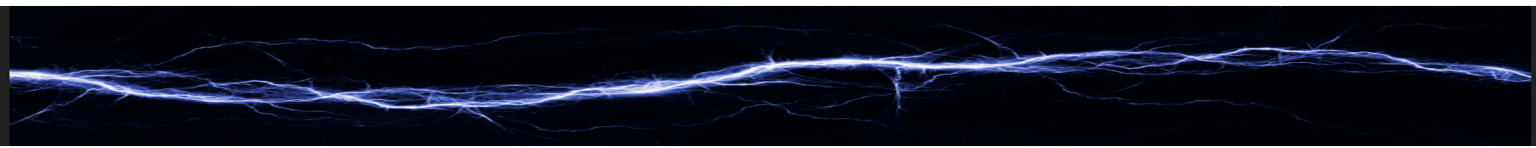

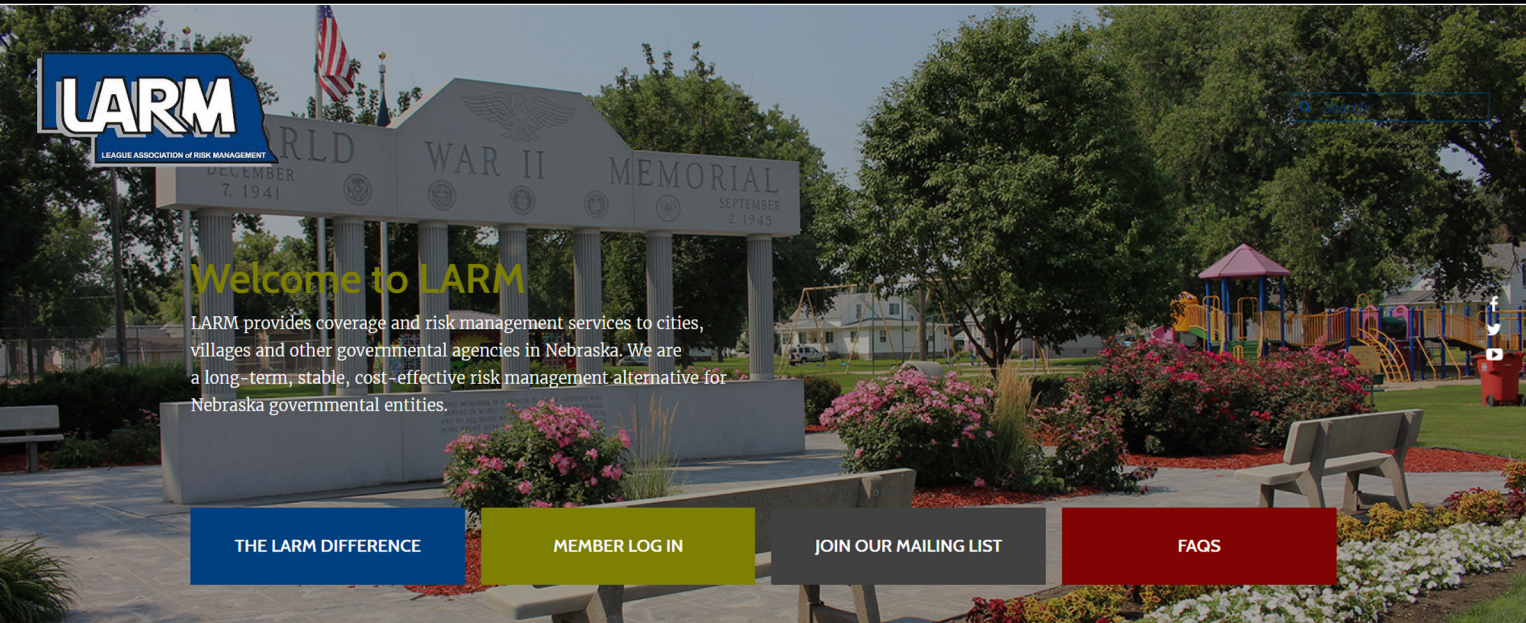
Auburn Board of Public Works
